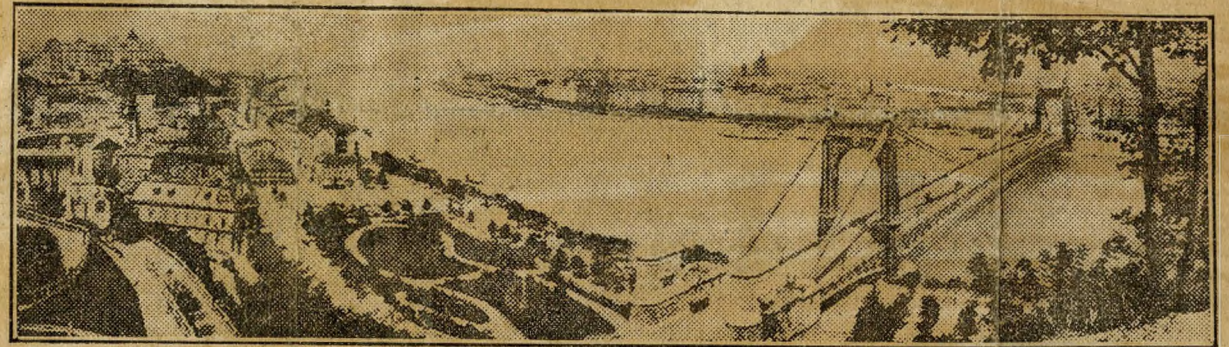
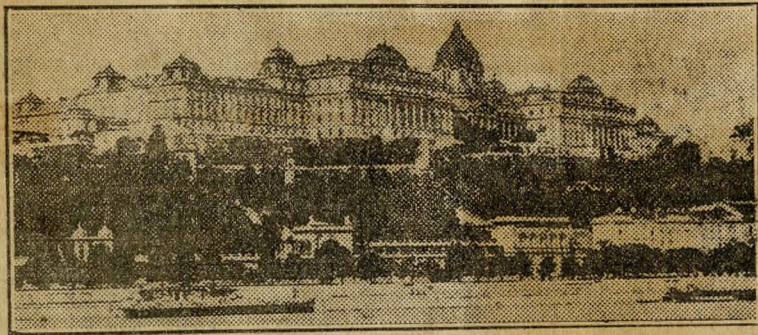

BUDAPEST is the city of surprises for foreigners who did not know it before: besides its splendid world-known situation such artistic treasures and cultural institutions are to be found here which would not be thought of in this part of Europe. There is a very interesting contrast between the two parts of the city: Buda and Pest. Buda with the romantic atmosphere of its historical past, surrounded by a chain of hills with a wonderfully rich variety in their character, facing the entirely modern Pest, consisting of a range of elegant streets and large avenues. The Hungarian capital has, in the last fifty years, developed into a most imposing metropole. The majestic Danube separates the ancient from the modern part. Several bridges (of which the Elizabeth bridge is one of the most remarkable in whole Europe by its daring structure of one span, and another called the Suspension bridge, which awakens the attention by its unrivalled architectural beauty) serve as a means of communication between Buda and Pest. On the Buda side we behold the very ancient hill, "St. Gellért," crowned by a citadel, the Royal Castle, the "Fisher's Bastion," a marvel of reproduction of ancient art with a fairylike view, whereas the most remarkable feature of the Pest side on the Danube is the magnificent House of Parliament, perhaps the biggest in the world. All this makes such a wonderful general impression the charm of which captivates even the most indifferent tourist.
